Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: Christmas Shows

We can't wait to hear our children sing and see them smiling on stage again! *At the time of writing, we are following Government Guidance that shows can go ahead with caution. I must advise that this could change at any time and we will update you if there are any changes needed.*

Therefore our current arrangements are as follows:

- One adult only can attend per performing child – a ticket will be given with your child's name and class on and must be shown on arrival. Do not swap tickets or try to bring in other people. Small children and babies must be in push chairs or on laps. High school siblings cannot attend in addition to the one adult.
- All adults **MUST** wear a mask or show medical evidence why they can't.
- Anyone coughing will be asked to leave. Do not attend with a high fever or loss of sense of taste or smell.

We will not be filming or live streaming the shows as not all children have permission and it causes disruption to seating and performing. The doors will remain open for ventilation.
