Children do need coats now please – and make sure they are named.







Protecting your child from stress

Children today often feel more stressed than we realise.

This is particularly important to remember because they are still at the stage where they are learning to understand their own thoughts and feelings, slowly developing emotionally and intellectually.

They often feel powerless and are under a lot of pressure.

More than ever we are seeing children share in adult worries, worries about climate change, people getting unwell and the subject of war. They do not have the emotional understanding that adult's do and this may cause them to hold some very scary and confused feelings.

How can parents help?

Firstly it is helpful to recognise that we share some of these worries and that we might need a space to talk about them, away from our children.

Parent carer self-care is so important. There is only so much that we can control, so focus on things for you. Slow down wherever you can. Take ten minutes to enjoy something for yourself.

Then think about what your child's week looks like and what activities they are involved in. Reduce the amount of news/media that they see and hear. Add into their routine some of their time, for them to play and be creative.

Think about what your child does when they are at home, video games, consoles and mobile phones can actually increase children's stress levels - Reduce the amount of game time they have and take time to connect. Take them outside; Physical activity and walks in nature are particularly helpful in reducing stress so try to make sure they can move outside every day.

And remember to have fun and to laugh with your child.

There is going to be another Parent Coffee Morning on Thursday 17th November.
