

#### **MESSAGE FROM MISS KONDO**

Once again our staff and pupils and parents have risen to the challenge of being sent home to self- isolate due to a positive case of COVID-19 in two of our year 1 classes. Well done and thank you to all.

Whilst COVID-19 is still very much a threat, bringing disruption to many of our lives, some normality was restored this week with Year 4 attending swimming and some Year 6s have had bike/road safety awareness lessons.

School Council met this week and spoke positively of the new lunchtime games and equipment; they were also very mature and reflective about our Behaviour policy and the system of reminders and house points – please do ask your child about this.

Please continue to follow all guidance as some lockdown restrictions are lifting. Miss Kondo

We have had a number of children coming in although they are poorly with fevers or coughs. They should be tested immediately – this can be done quite quickly and could prevent a whole class or other people from becoming ill or having to self-isolate.

\*\* It is very important that you keep your child at home if ANYONE in the house has symptoms, especially siblings. It is also important to know the symptoms of COVID-19 (below), to be tested if anyone has symptoms and to note the first day of symptoms\*\*.

Do not send your child in to school if you are ill with symptoms and/or are waiting for a test result.

Siblings of children who are sent to isolate due to being a contact can still attend school.

Of course a sibling of a child who tested positive would not be able to attend school.

We also ask that you continue to respect the need to wear face masks when dropping off and collecting from school and only one adult per family. Please continue to do this.

Thank you to everyone who does this or politely lets us know they are exempt from wearing a face mask.

Please refrain from using your mobile phone whilst dropping off and collecting your child.





#### **ROAD SAFETY**
